

# **2018 Annual Report**

**When this website was designed in 2007, the experts included statistical tables, one of which was a list of the 50 most frequently downloaded articles for each day of the last 30 days. Unfortunately it did not list a grand total of views of an article dating back to its original posting but approximations can be made.**

**Several years after the MLHP website was “launched” I noticed that the federal laws expelling the Winnebago and Sioux-Dakota Tribes from Minnesota after the Dakota-U.S. War of 1862 had not been collected and published. I copied the two removal laws of 1863, the three appropriations bills, inserted excerpts from an article on the removals by Professor William E. Lass and posted them in April 2012. It has not left the 50 most viewed articles since; I estimate that this short article has been viewed well over 3,000 times since it went up.**

**In January 2014 Thomas Olson’s “Blockbusters: Minnesota’s Movie Men Slug it out With Movie Moguls, 1938-1948” was posted. While it took some time, it eventually was discovered by visitors to this website. I estimate it has been viewed over 4,000 times since it went up. That number should double in the next 3 or 4 years.**

**Of course the term “visitors” covers different behaviors: the person who starts the article, stops and never returns; the one who starts, stops and finishes days later; and the one who reads the article two or three times.**

**In 1989 Professor William E. Lass, Professor Emeritus of History, Mankato State University, delivered a paper “The First Attempt to Organize Dakota Territory” at a conference in Billings, Montana. I did not attend this conference but I have attended similar ones and guess that the audience for Professor’ Lass’ paper was about three dozen.**

Two years later it was included in a collection of essays published by the University of Washington Press (and now out of print). Professor Lass gave me permission to republish his article on the MLHP and I did so in September 2008. I estimate that it has been viewed at least 1,500 times since then. In the coming years, hundreds more will read it and come to value historical scholarship of the first rank.<sup>1</sup>

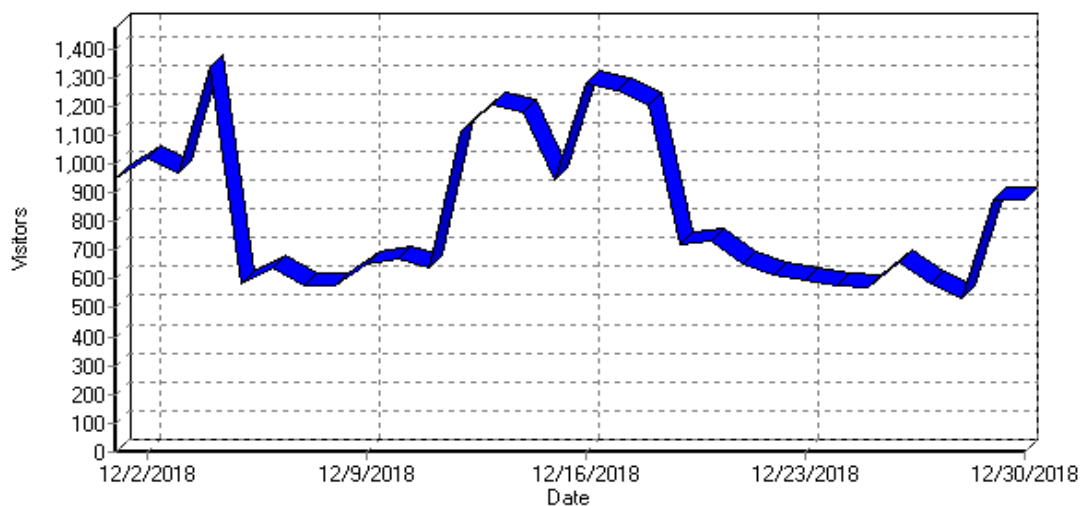
“The Great Land Ordinances” by the late Jonathan Hughes and “The Northwest Ordinance in Historical Perspective” by the late Douglas C. North and Andrew R. Rutten, both posted in 2011, have been viewed well over 3,000 times.

The point of these anecdotes is to emphasize that even history articles posted on a narrowly-focused online website such as this attract, over time, large numbers of viewers.

Turning to the statistics, the numbers for 2018 are little changed from 2017. Only the statistics for December 2018 were saved.

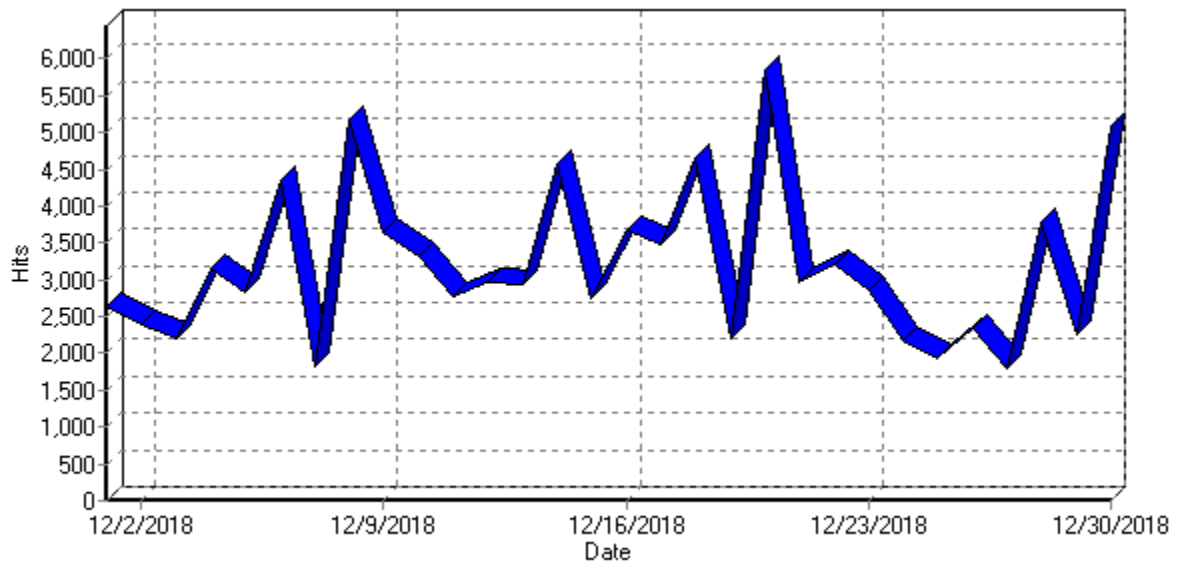
**Daily Visitors, December 2 – December 30, 2018**

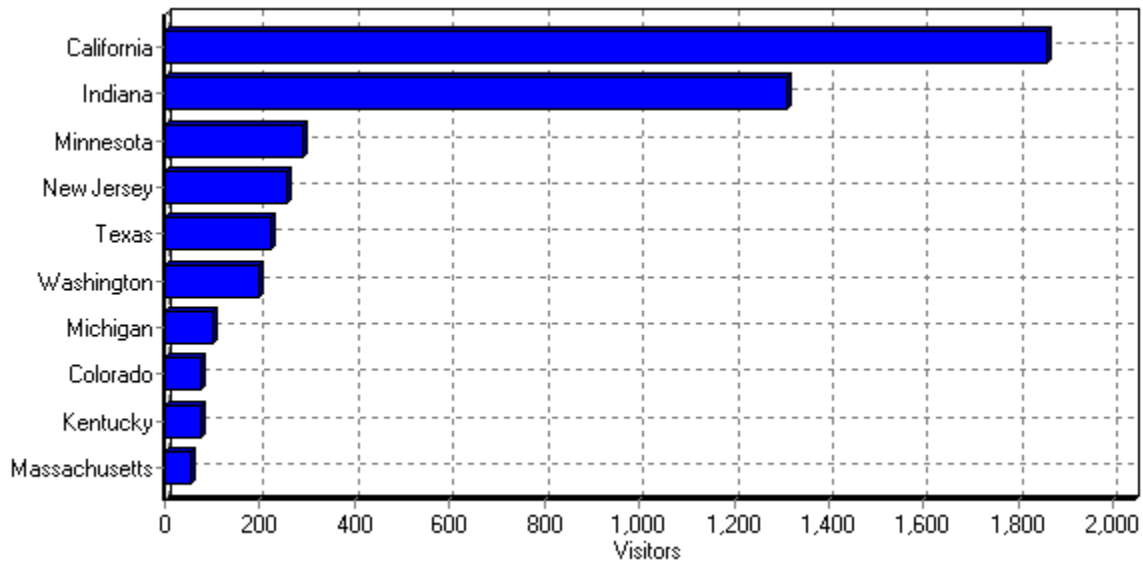
