**TO THE HONORABLE JUDGES OF THE DISTRICT COURT OF
RAMSEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA:**

Charles C. Sharp, a former Member of the Bar of this city, was born in New York City in April, 1859, and received a common and high school education in the schools of that city. He was the eldest son of Robert and Fannie Sharp; his father was a prominent merchant of New York City. Mr. Sharp was married to Henrietta Hayden in 1879 in New York City; he moved to St. Paul in 1890; he practiced law in St. Paul, Minnesota, until 1912. He was admitted to the Bar of this State, March 13, 1902; he practiced his profession in Tacoma, Washington, from 1912 until the time of his death, January 20th, 1928.

While a resident of St. Paul, he was a Member of Shakinah Lodge No. 171 A. F. and A. M.

He is survived by his wife, Henrietta Sharp, and three daughters, Florence Murphy, Henrietta Sharp and Francis Maurin, all of whom reside in Tacoma, Washington, and by two brothers, Warren W. Sharp and Arthur B. Sharp, residing in St. Paul, Minnesota.

Mr. Sharp practiced successfully for a number of years in St. Paul and is well remembered by many members of our Bar.
