The Committee appointed by this Court to draft Resolutions in Memory of Henry W. Morgan, deceased, ask permission of the Court to report at this time.

Henry W. Morgan was born at Gloucester County, New Jersey, near Camden, May 1, 1860. He attended various private and Public schools in his native State and finally graduated from Lehigh University, Bethlehem, Pa. After his graduation he engaged in railway engineering work for a season, later commenced the study of law in Philadelphia, Pa.

He came to Minnesota in 1887, married Miss Mary Kelly of Hyde Park, Wabasha County, Minnesota, and located at Lake City, entered upon the practice of law, continued therein until the time of his decease, which occurred on the 13th day of June, 1918.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That in the death of Mr. Morgan, this bar has lost an able member, the community in which he resided, an active and patriotic citizen, and his family a kind and indulgent husband and father.
