ADELBERT R. TAYLOR

TO THE HONORABLE DISTRICT COURT and MEMBERS OF THE BAR OF HENNEPIN COUNTY:

Adelbert R. Taylor, Williston Road, Minnetonka Mills District, and formerly for many years a resident of Minneapolis, died unexpectedly on Wednesday, June 14, 1939.

Mr. Taylor was born December 28, 1864, in Westfield, Massachusetts, but had been a resident of Minneapolis and vicinity for some sixty-five years, — his parents, the late Mr. and Mrs. John D. Taylor, having moved to Minnesota when he was a child.

He graduated from Carleton College, Northfield, in the same class with the late Justice Pierce Butler, and from the University of Minnesota Law School, Class of 1890 (sic), and had been a practicing lawyer in Hennepin County for upwards of forty-six years. He was, for many years, a member of the law firm of Koon, Whelan & Bennett, this City, but in later years practiced independently, with offices at No. 617—McKnight Building.

Mr. Taylor was a man of honor, a good citizen, a lawyer ethical in his profession, well-read, and a Christian gentleman. At Minnetonka Mills, where he lived in his later years, he delighted in the cultivation of fine vegetables, and had created a market for his products in Minneapolis. His gardens were his hobby, and he took care of them by rising early in the morning, before coming to town for his day's work in his profession.

His kindly sympathy, cheerful example and high ideals as a friend and counselor will be greatly missed.
